**CALL FOR COMMENTS ON THE DRAFT LIST OF PUBLIC LAUNCH SITES IN
KWAZULU-NATAL**

1. I, Sihle Zikalala, Member of the Executive Council (MEC) responsible for Economic Development, Tourism and Environmental Affairs in the Province of KwaZulu-Natal, acting in terms of regulation 2(1) of the Management of Public Launch Sites in the Coastal Zone Regulations, in terms of the National Environmental Management: Integrated Coastal Management Amendment Act, 2014 (Act No. 36 of 2014), give notice to publish in the *Provincial Gazette* the draft list of public launch sites for KwaZulu-Natal. Comments from the public are hereby invited before the final list is published in the *Provincial Gazette*.

2. A “public launch site” means a site where a vessel may be launched by members of the public in the coastal zone but excludes those sites in protected areas and in proclaimed harbours.

3. The listing process will designate official public launch sites in KwaZulu-Natal and identify who the respective management bodies are.

4. In terms of the regulations, members of the public may only launch a vessel from an official site. The regulations exclude privately used launch sites.

5. A “vessel” excludes non-motorised waterborne craft which do not require a vehicle or any other equipment to launch into the water.

6. The proposed sites identified by the KwaZulu-Natal Government, in consultation with the municipalities, can be seen in the table which follows.
