SCHEDULE ERADICATION AND CONTROL OF UNDESIRABLE PLANT SPECIES

Measures should be taken to eradicate the following plant species and to combat their spreading in the area:

- *Acacia cyclops,*
- *Acacia saligna,*
- *Acacia longifolia,*
- *Hakea spp.*

and any other exotic plant species which has proliferated in the area to such an extent as to threaten the survival of the indigenous plant species in the area.

COMBATING OF SOIL EROSION

Measures should be taken to combat soil erosion in the area.
