DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENT AFFAIRS AND TOURISM

The Minister of Environment Affairs and Tourism has issued the directions in the Schedule in terms of section 10 (1) of the Environment Conservation Act, 1982 (Act 100 of 1982).

SCHEDULE

1. In these directions, unless the context otherwise indicates, every expression to which a meaning has been assigned in the Environment Conservation Act, 1982 (Act 100 of 1982), shall have the same meaning.

2. No person shall in respect of land situated within a nature area—
 - (a) erect any building or alter any existing building; or
 - (b) subdivide any land,

except under the authority of a permit and subject to the conditions set out therein, issued in terms of section 4 (2) of the Physical Planning Act, 1967 (Act 88 of 1967).
